It resembles an ice cream cone fully covered in three-dimensional fabric. This ensures a highly contemporary appeal and muffles noise as well. The hollow body and lid are made of expanded polypropylene, the damping cylinder and steel weight at the bottom ensure it bounces back like a roly-poly toy. The tapered base is made of black, anti-slip plastic. Stand-up weighs just 4.5 kilos with a strap to take it from room to room, or perhaps for a spell al fresco...

Apart from the playful aspect, its tilted stance when not in use underscores one of its key features. It shows that it's a dynamic, flexible support and not a stable, static stool.
