Versatile table culture.

A table is perhaps the most important element of furniture for influencing togetherness within a company. In a meeting at the workplace, in a conference or in an executive's office – this is where people meet to assure themselves of their common identity and to develop new ideas.

For companies that assign as much value to openness, lightness and dynamics as to high-level quality and enduring elegance, the Logon range offers table culture of the highest degree of excellence and design quality. The rounded laminated wood lipping with integral, impact-resilient profile, the slender uprights and the elegantly modelled foot sections in die-cast aluminium provide an abundance of options for individual tables and table configurations with an appearance of transparent, optical lightness. An ingenious tensioning principle, drawn from aircraft construction, permits minimum material thicknesses.

Logon provides a perfect solution to virtually all requirements for tables – as a single table or a linked configuration, on adjustable glides for levelling out floor irregularities or on castors for mobile application. From reception areas and meeting rooms to large-scale conference layouts, from robustness for application in project offices to an executive boardroom. All in a distinctive and coherent design language that communicates future-oriented awareness.



Prestigious, barrel-shaped table configuration in cherry veneer with anodized uprights and bright chromium-plated foot sections to seat 20. Tilt-up techni-stations for serving digital projectors are integrated into the table tops. A perfect team: Modus cantilever chair with elegantly stitched, slim cushion.

A management workplace with Modus Executive, perfectly matched with the conference configuration: the large single tables, measuring up to 240 x 120 cm (94½" x 47¼"), cut an excellent figure as a workplace. The modesty panel in fluted, extruded aluminium profile also functions as cable management and may be fitted to any type of table configuration.



Logon. Understated – yet intriguing.

The extremely optically light, aesthetic impression made by Logon tables is due to an ingenious principle inspired by aircraft construction: foot sections and table top bearers are firmly braced by means of threaded rods in the uprights. Minimum material cross sections can therefore be used to achieve a particularly high degree of stability. The result: a table surface of 240 x 120 cm (94½" x 47¼") that appears to have floating surfaces and does not require any additional bracing. The recessed underframe ensures spacious legroom and versatile seating layouts. For both a desk and a linked conference configuration.

The precisely modelled foot sections and the table top bearers are in high-grade die-cast aluminium. The vertical uprights and the horizontal underframe comprise extruded aluminium profile. Besides standardized sizes and formats, the modular frame structure allows customized table configurations that are exactly coordinated with individual interior forms and space requirements.





Open-centred, oval table arrangement to seat 32: a free-standing segment has been inserted at the front of the linked configuration to allow the space in the centre to be accessed. Microphone modules and table "portals" for all network connections have been integrated into the customized table top segments. The version with pale laminate tops, solid wood lipping with integral impact-resilient profile and bright chromium-plated frames withstands a high level of wear without leaving signs of use. Comfortable, light, stackable Sito cantilever models have been selected as seating.



Excellence in detail: the bright chromium-plated frame and the cantilevered table top with the distinctive impact-resilient profile integrated into the solid wood lipping convey quality and elegance. They harmonize perfectly with the bright chromium-plated armrests and frames of the luxurious Modus conference chair.



Elongated, open-centred table configuration for 18. Modus conference chairs with automatic synchro-adjustment and self-centring mechanism create a calm, ordered appearance, while providing first-class ergonomic comfort for longer periods of sitting too.

Logon. Decision-maker.

If decision-makers are expected to take a high degree of responsibility, a conference room should be furnished and equipped to promote processes focused on agreement and decision in the most optimal manner. For example, by means of a table configuration with rounded long edges to encourage interaction and communication among conference participants. The exposed places at the sides facilitate more tightly steered, more goal-oriented conference management. Participants can use digital projection for visual presentation of their ideas by means of integral table "portals" housing plug-and-play modules for media, power supply and network connections.

The functionality of the table configuration is as important as high quality. A boardroom does after all symbolize the value that a community assigns to meetings held there. With this in mind, table frames with a bright chromium-plated finish and solid wood lipping have been selected that convey precision and elegance as convincingly as the high quality of the leather-covered Modus conference chairs.



Conference table in a boardroom: the single table with a barrel-shaped top with pear veneer provides ample space for six. Modus cantilever chairs, featuring a bright chromium-plated frame, seats with leather cushions and a back with semi-transparent stretch fabric, and the Avera seating arrangement for informal communication are coordinated with the frame and surface finish of the Logon table.

Logon. Versions, accessories and integral techni-modules.

Standard versions of Logon comprise surface finishes in laminate, linoleum and real wood veneer. Leather inserts or metal surfaces may also be integrated into table tops.

Foot sections are optionally in the colour silver or black, clear anodized, polished or bright chromium-plated. This allows finely tuned coordination with the ambience of the conference interior – with existing seating, an architectural feature or a functional element.

Not only are Logon surface finishes, formats and forms customized to meet your requirements, but also the inclusion of state-of-the-art conference technology: ranging from cable outlets, tilt-up techni-stations with a choice

of different modules for "plug-and-play" solutions to the integration of telephone conference modules, complete AV systems, digital projectors or retractable displays. Function

Single tables for application in offices, and system components for permanently linked table configurations in conference rooms. Ideal for combining with Confair folding tables for versatile, partitionable conference rooms.

Frame

Foot section in die-cast aluminium, chromium-plated, polished or coated according to Wilkhahn colour samples. Aluminium profile uprights, clear anodized, bright chromium-plated or coated. Die-cast aluminium table top bearer coated in either platinum or black, depending on foot section version.

Aluminium profile underframe coated in the colour platinum or black, depending on foot section version. Centre underframe for table depths 75 (29½") and 90 cm (35⅝"); two separate underframes for table depths 105 (41⅜") and 120 cm (47¼"). Adjustable glides in black polyamide; lockable castors in black polyamide (models 621/5 and 623/51 only).

Table tops

Particle board with concealed solid wood lipping or laminated wood lipping and integral, impact-resilient polypropylene profile in black; system elements with straight edge without profile. Top surfaces optionally in laminate, real wood veneer according to Wilkhahn woodstain colour samples (table top thickness 27 mm (1⅛")) or linoleum (table top thickness 30 mm (1⅞")).

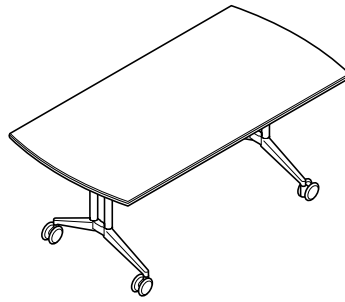
The key is ingenious layout planning: conference interiors with prestigious, high-quality furniture may be used for varied applications with a combination of linearly linked Logon elements and Confair folding tables in coordinated dimensions. In this example, two conference rooms for 22 participants each can be transformed into an open forum layout to accommodate 40, or also into a banquetting hall with four long, spacious tables, each seating 12. In the latter case, the folding tables would then be used for a buffet.
